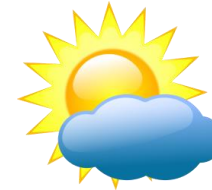




Year 1 Newsletter Summer 2 2018

Phonics



The National Phonics Screening Test begins on Monday 11th June. Children can be tested any day that week. Please practise the Phonics booklet we have sent home and encourage your child to put sound buttons on the words to help them.

Reading

We will be reading stories with predictable and patterned language, in particular Julia Donaldson stories (author of the Gruffalo). Maybe visit your local library and share some of her stories.



Maths

In maths we will be looking at money, weight, volume, position and direction. Please discuss British coins and notes and clarify left and right with you child!



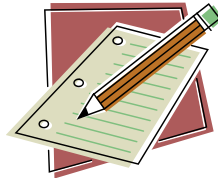
Science
