Help your child to use their phonics knowledge by helping them to practise for their spelling tests. If your child is retaking the phonics test, please support them to identify sounds in their reading books.

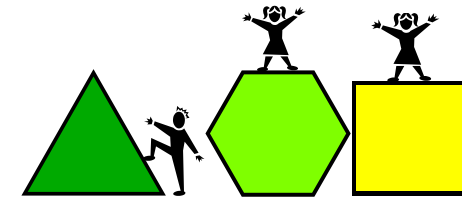
Reading



Please continue to support your child by hearing them read daily and sharing your own favourite stories with them. To develop their reading skills, ask your child to predict what will happen in the end of the story or how a character may be feeling. We will be looking at traditional tales this term, Try your local library for new books to share.

Maths

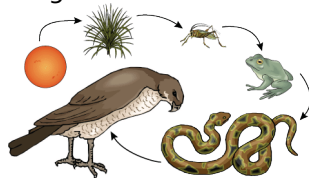
Take every opportunity to read, write, order numbers and count accurately.



We will continue with the times tables challenge. The children will be naming and writing fractions and finding $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity.

Science

The children will be focusing on living things, their habitats and food chains. We will also be monitoring the growth of the bulbs we planted.
