Our swimming lessons start the first Tuesday after the summer half term. Year 2 and Year 1 children will be swimming on a Tuesday *and* Thursday, Reception Red Class on a *Tuesday only* and Reception Orange Class on a *Thursday only*, all will be taught by a qualified swimming instructor. This year we are asking for a contribution of £9.00 for each child in Years 1 and 2 and £4.50 for Reception children, this works out at £0.75 per session – we are unable to give refunds if your child is absent or lessons cancelled for any reason. Your contribution goes towards the hire of the pool from Kingsway Junior School and the cost of the swimming instructor. If we do not receive enough contributions we may have to reduce the number of swimming lessons.

Children will need to bring:-

- named plastic bag for wet clothes
- named one piece swimming costume or trunks
- named towel
- named coat or fleece
- swimming hats must be worn if hair is longer than jaw length. (Hats may be available to purchase from the Junior school)
- Long hair must be tied back.
- No goggles.

No jewellery or plasters to be worn. We understand that pupils who have recently had their ears pierced do not want to take them out, you may send in tape to secure **stud earrings** which cannot be removed.
