Free School Meal Applications for September 2013

If you are in receipt of free school meals and milk you do not need to make another application for the next school year as it will be done automatically. Following the automated renewals, families who no longer appear to qualify will be advised by letter that their free school meals will cease at the end of this term (24th July 2013). If you receive a letter and you feel that you should still be entitled to free meals and milk you can make a new application and further checks will be carried out. If you do not receive a letter you can assume that your child will continue to receive free school meals for the next academic year.
