# Help Your Child with Reading, Writing and Phonics Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2.15 pm and 6.30 pm

There will be a reading, writing and phonics presentation on Tuesday 10th February at 2.15 pm and again at 6.30 pm. Both presentations will be the same and last approximately 45 minutes. The presentation will show how we teach reading, writing and phonics within school and how you can support your child at home and build on their skills. We will be sending out a letter next week with a reply slip – we hope you have time to join us.

#### **Year 2 Recorder Lessons**

Exciting news - we have been successful in finding a recorder teacher for our year 2 children! The lessons will be on a Tuesday during the afternoon and they started this week. Each child will be issued with their own recorder to use once the teacher has taught the children a few basics. When they have mastered the basics the children will be allowed to take the recorders home to practice something for you to look forward to!?
