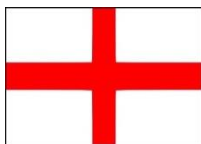

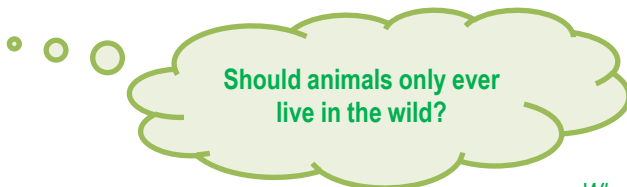
Attendance for week beginning 30th March 2015 – Blue class received the Attendance Cup!
