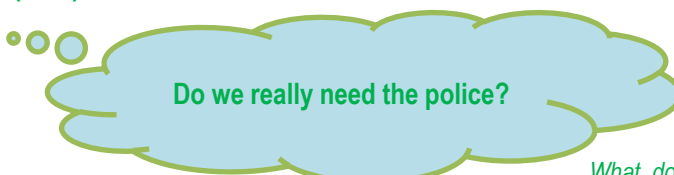
Attendance

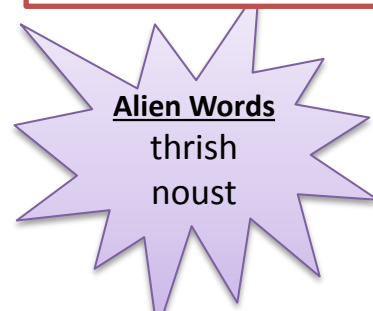
