Reception

In maths this week Reception children used water based activities to learn about capacity, floating and sinking. The children filled an empty container to different levels and used appropriate language to describe the water level. They explored how to make the container full or empty again.

The children used vegetables for their floating and sinking experiment. They were asked to predict whether the vegetables would float or sink before placing them in the water one at a time to see if they were correct. They discussed why they thought the vegetables would float or sink.



Year 1

Year 1 had a fun packed day at Aldenham Country Park yesterday. They learnt about bears and what they need to survive in the wild and then went on a bear hunt. Once the bears had been hunted down the children worked in teams to build a den for them. After all their hard work they were free to explore the nature trails, the farm and the 100 Akar Wood. Today they have written a recount of their day. They thought about the journey, and ordered all the different park activities using time conjunctions.



Year 2

Father Robert joined Year 2 children for an RE lesson focusing on Identity and Belonging.

Through a question and answer session the children were able to learn what his work as a priest involves and how it has changed his life.

After the whole class discussion they recorded their findings in their workbooks and were asked "Would I like his job and why?"

Safeguarding

The Every Child Matters Agenda requires all agencies to take responsibility for safeguarding and promoting the welfare of every child. This is to enable them to be healthy, stay safe, make a positive contribution, enjoy and achieve.
