Year 2 – Ordering Instructions

This week Year 2 have been learning about instructions.

Year 1 – Ball Skills

In PE this week Year 1 focused on their throwing and catching skills.

After warming up the children were asked to work in pairs to count how many catches and throws they could do in one minute. Still in pairs they practised throwing the ball to each other with and without a bounce.

They talked about the best techniques to use e.g. watching the ball and throwing with or without a bounce.
