The children worked in pairs or alone and were encouraged to use their own initiative to select from matching, sequencing, counting and ordering maths based games using Education City software.

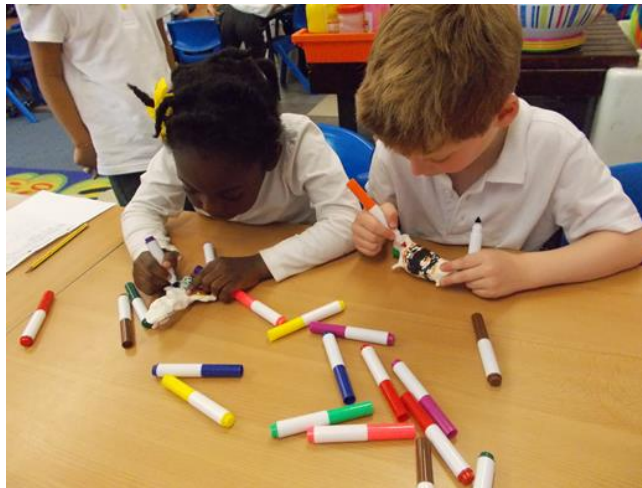


Year 1 - Diorama
