Safeguarding – Stranger Danger

This week we were visited by PCSO Keith Sayers and his colleague, PCSO Ryan Bailey, to talk to the children about Stranger Danger. He explained how strangers are people we don't know or don't know very well, you can't tell the difference between a good stranger and bad stranger just by looking at them. They talked about using the motto NO, GO, YELL, TELL if approached by a stranger who scares or touches them. Say **NO, GO** - run away, **YELL** – yell as loud as you can and **TELL** – tell a trusted adult what happened. Please talk to your children about safe places to go if they find themselves in this situation, such as a shop, a school or to the house of a friend that they know very well if they can't get home. Remember to be aware of Stranger Danger on the internet as well. Please stress how important it is that they tell an adult who they trust about what has happened straight away.

E-Safety - Snapchat

One of the features of the latest update on Snapchat, Snap Map, tracks and shares a users, and their friends, exact location, time of day they were there and speed of travel. The users location can automatically update on Snap Map as soon as the Snapchat app is opened. If you or your children use Snapchat and don't want your location visible you need to ensure you have 'Only Me' (Ghost Mode) setting on so your location won't be visible on the map.
