Happy New Year to all of our Kingsway Families! It is lovely to see everyone back to school - the snow was very exciting as the children arrived! This week. I have seen the children thrilled to be back at school and engaged with their learning. Reception have been amazing at continuing to learn new phonics sounds, Year 1 have been planting seeds to monitor how quickly they grow and Year 2 have been reading different versions of the Traditional Tale, Rapunzel. Year 1 We have been busy exploring odd and even numbers in Maths. We spotted the alternate pattern on the number line and how we can tell if the number is odd and even by looking at the last digit. Is 125 an odd or an even number? In Art we learned to use different watercolour techniques such as lines, stroke, splatter and wet in wet. As part of our Toys topic in history, our show and tell this term is sharing interesting toys from now or from the past.

Year 2 This week, we started our learning about Traditional Tales- focusing on the story of Rapunzel. We talked about the features of these stories, often involving a princess and a prince, a castle, forests and bad characters. They always end in a 'happily ever after'. We sequenced the story of Rapunzel and retold it, focusing on the most exciting parts! In art, we learnt what an architect is! We then looked at a range of architecture, sketching landmarks from different perspectives.


