Head Teacher's Award

We've had a busy first full week in Reception! We have been discussing what makes a good friend and exploring ways we can be helpful to one another. In phonics, we have been singing nursery rhymes and working on our listening skills, identifying syllables and finding rhyming words. Using these nursery rhymes as inspiration, we got creative this week by making fish, fishing rods, spiders, and boats out of a variety of materials.

Year 1 visited the garden and thought about command verbs we can use while we are gardening. Eg: Put on your wellies! Rake the soil! In Maths we played dominoes, looking at the patterns on the dominoes and subitising the numbers. In Art, inspired by Molly Haslund, a Danish artist, we explored drawing circles using compasses that we created using meter sticks, tapes and chalks.



Year 2 This week we have been learning about the structure of narratives (stories) and noticed that often a problem happens in them. We discussed the problems that happened in 'The Frog and the Stranger' and how the Rat helped solve the problems. The children then used drama to plan their narratives, thinking about their own disaster and how Rat saves the day! In Maths, we have been learning about equality and inequality. We used the more than $>$, less than $<$ and equal $=$ symbols to compare numbers to 100.
