Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to be able to write the first newsletter of the year and am looking forward to welcoming Year 1 and Year 2 children to school, tomorrow, Tuesday 3rd September and our new Reception children to school on Thursday 5th September, all at the start time of 8:45.

I am very much aware of the responsibility that my staff and I have in ensuring that the highest standard of teaching and learning is achieved. We have a hugely committed team and wonderful children, which of course, is a great place for us all to start the year. The needs of the children are always paramount in the life and decision making within a school. I strongly believe in providing the children with exciting, creative and meaningful learning experiences, which build their enthusiasm for learning and help them to grow and develop positively in a variety of ways. You can be assured that, as Headteacher, I will strive to create the best education for your child/children whilst they are members of our school family. I think it is crucial to involve the children and their families as partners in their education as well as building a whole school community which thrives on mutual respect and values positive relationships. I believe it is important that you have a voice and that as a school we are approachable and allocate time to listen to your concerns, worries or thoughts about the school. I will attempt to be at the gate before and after school each day. I look forward to meeting more of you in the coming weeks and thank you for your continued support.

I would like to take this opportunity to inform you of some useful information you will need for the start of this school year.

School will start promptly at 8:45am. Please use the entrances on Ross Crescent or Briar Road. Children need to be in full school uniform, including sensible black shoes. All clothing needs to be clearly named. Yellow class children should come to school in their PE kit for the first day. Red and Orange Class Children (Reception) will not need to wear their PE kit this week.

If you need to speak to a member of staff about your child, try to catch them at the end of the school day when all the other children and parents have gone. For any urgent matters or appointments please email or telephone the school office. If someone else is collecting your child, please make sure they are over 18 years old and let the school office know the name of the person collecting in advance. Children will not be allowed to go home with another person unless their parent has informed the school first.

If your child is unwell please keep them at home but also telephone the school office before 9.30 am on 01923 675005.

Headteachers no longer have the discretion to allow time off during a school year for a family holiday, days out, weddings etc, or to agree extended leave for parents to visit their country of origin. If you child is absent from school because of a holiday or family occasion which has not been agreed with in advance, this may be classed as unauthorised and you may be fined and legal action taken against you. If there are exceptional circumstances please make an appointment to discuss these with me.

School Meals - Food Allergies, Intolerances and Cultural Diets
