Reception In literacy, we have been reading "Mrs Armitage on Wheels" by Quentin Blake. We labelled different parts of a bike and thought about what we could add to our own bikes, just like Mrs Armitage. In Maths, we've been learning about equal and unequal groups and discussing how we can identify the difference between them. Equal groups have the same number of parts or objects, an unequal group will have more or less than the other group.

Year 1 In English this week we have been reading 'The Big Book of Bugs' by Yuval Zommer. We found out what minibeasts look like, how they move and where they live. We wrote the life cycle of the butterfly and we know how they changed from a tiny egg to a fluttering butterfly. In Maths, we were exploring multiplication. We looked at pictures and used arrays to represent the sum, for example I can see three groups of five, $3 \times 5 = 15$.



Year 2 This week we started reading a book called 'The Lost Homework'. It is about a boy called Sonny from a Romany Traveller family. We learnt the meaning of some Romany words and explored what Sonny was like as a character. In Maths, we have been learning the names and properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes.
