

Year 2 This week, in PE, we have been busy with sports day practice. We worked at developing our skills in numerous sport activities such as long jump, shot put and target practice. In science, we continued our learning about living things. We explored that animals have offspring, which are baby animals. Not all offspring look like their adult; tadpoles and frogs look very different, but lambs and sheep look alike.



Year 1 We have been exploring a non fiction text about bugs. This week we have invented new bugs and wrote an explanation text describing their appearance and movements. We also wrote a fictional life cycle of their growth and published them in a book. In Design and Technology this term our project is to make a windmill. We made our turbines and attached them to the axle. Next week we will build the structure and assemble them together.



Reception This week in Literacy, we read "The Helpful Digger" and discussed examples of when we have been helpful and the importance of using our manners. We examined the different parts of a digger and designed our own, carefully considering which parts would need to move to scoop up soil. The children then created their diggers, using split pins for the moving parts and thinking of various ways their diggers could help people. In Maths, we explored the concepts of doubling and halving. We learned that when we double or halve something, each group should have equal amounts.
