Where learning is fun!

Thank you to the children for their entertaining Harvest assemblies today, we are so proud of their singing! It was a wonderful end to a long half term. The children have settled into their new classes and made good progress with their learning. Year 1 In English, we went for an Autumn walk using our senses to gather ideas that we could use to create an Autumn poem. We used adjectives to describe our nouns, for example, cold fresh air, round shiny conkers, creamy hot chocolate. In Science, we learned about seasonal changes, how the weather changes during Autumn and what happens to the deciduous trees this time of the year. In Art, we celebrated our wonderful work with an Art Gallery where the children were able to say which art work they like and why.









Year 2 This week we reviewed our number bonds to 10. We played a card game called 'Tens Down', where we had to make complements of 10 to make a 'trick'. Whoever managed to have the most tricks when the deck ran out, won! We then used our knowledge of complements of 10, to make complements to 100. In science, we started our observation over time. We planted daffodil bulbs so we can observe their life cycle over the next few months. We learnt that bulbs don't need sunlight to grow, as they are under the soil and already have a food store.













Reception We have explored the vibrant celebrations of Diwali and harvest festivals, focusing on the similarities and differences in how and why people celebrate these special events. In our Maths lessons, we explored the fascinating world of patterns. We embarked on a pattern hunt, looking for the repeated designs in our environment, such as those found on bricks, clothing and animals. We created beautiful Rangoli patterns, keeping in mind that a pattern is something that repeats in a logical way.


