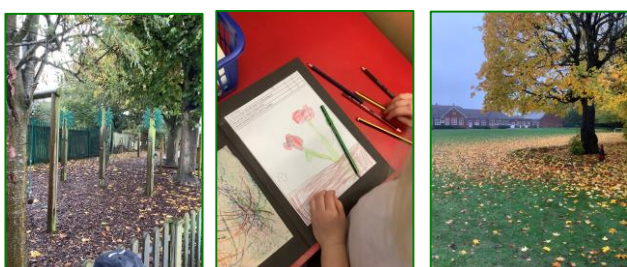

Reception We have been creating our own patterns this week, thinking carefully about the unit of repeat they want to use. We have been reading 'After The Storm' by Nick Butterworth and have been making puppets and books to help us retell the story.

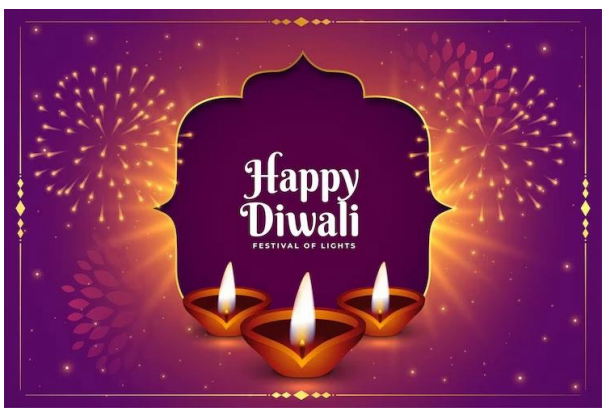
