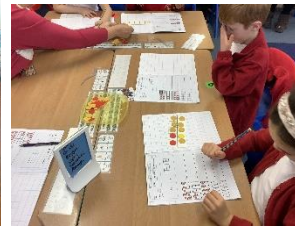

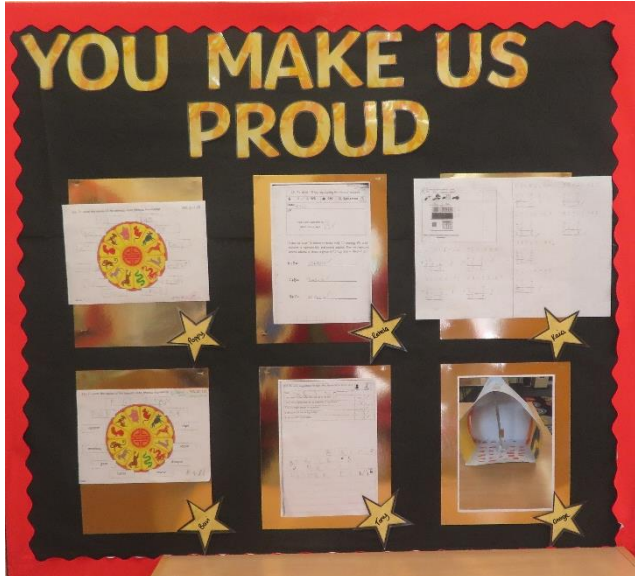
Year 1 This week in Maths we were practicing adding using the think 5 and think 10 methods to help us. We have been using 10s frames and counters to help show us how to regroup the numbers. In Art, we have been exploring the artist Paul Klee, looking at his paintings and discussing what we see and how it makes us feel. We then tried to recreate one of his paintings thinking about what shapes and colours he used using different art materials such as oil pastels, pencils and coloured pencils.

Reception We've been exploring the Chinese New Year, including how the animals were chosen for the zodiac. This journey led us to discover the exciting traditions of Lion and Dragon dances, which are an integral part of the celebrations. The children even had the opportunity to create their own versions of these dances. In Maths, our focus has been on the concept of number magnitude. We've been learning about how numbers increase by one equally each time in our number system, reinforcing the predictable pattern of counting.



Year 2 This week, we started learning about programming in computing. We used code blocks to create a programme, instructing the computer on what to do. If we made a mistake, we had to debug our code! In PE, we continued our gymnastics sequences. These involved a jump, movement and balance. Some of us were very brave and chose climbing the rope as our movement.
