Year 2 This week we have been learning about telling the time. We know that the minute hand is longer and goes up in intervals of five, but the hour hand is shorter and goes up in ones. We practiced telling the time at o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to, with some of us even challenging ourselves with telling the time to the nearest five minutes! In computing, we have been programming using Scratch Jr. The children recreated the story of 'The Gruffalo' by setting a background, adding text and a 'sprite'. We even got our 'sprites' to move and talk throughout scenes.



Reception This week has been a real celebration of our learning from this term. We've had so much fun exploring the similarities and differences between the different minibeasts we've learnt about. We even got creative and made our very own minibeasts, thinking about what features they could have like wings, shells, spots, or patterns. In Maths, we continued to explore number the 10 and beyond, noticing how the pattern in our number system reveals that there's 10 and 1 more for 11, 10 and 2 more for 12, and so on. It's been a brilliant week of discovery and creativity!



Year 1 We had an amazing term exploring printing in Art. We created a copy of an image using different techniques such as observational drawing, rubbing and printing.
