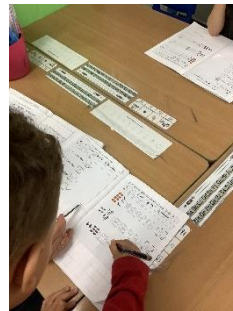

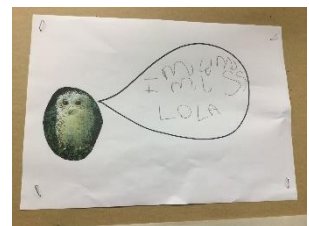

**Year 2** In maths, we learnt about subtraction by finding the 'difference'. We played a game called 'Bank the difference' where we drew 2 number cards and represented these with counters. Whoever drew the bigger amount, got to keep the difference between the smaller and bigger number. The first one to reach 20 was the winner! In D&T, we continued planning our fairground wheel. We considered which materials would be best to use, based on their properties. To decide this, we explored a range of materials describing them using vocabulary like 'strong', 'transparent' and 'waterproof'.

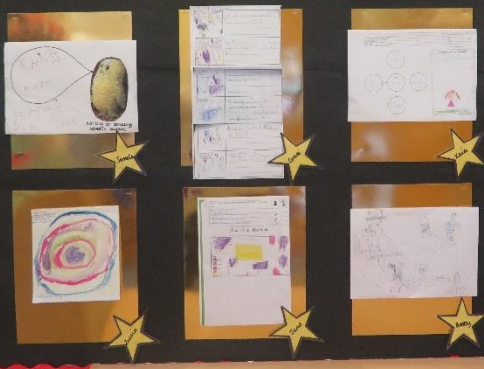

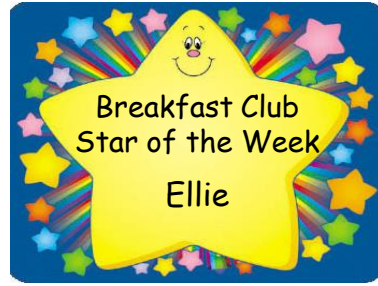
