Where learning is fun!

Thank you to the parents who attended the 'come and see phonics' sessions this week. I know how useful you found them, and how impressed you were with your child's attitude and engagement in their learning. We really love being able to share how important learning is for our children and how well they respond to the teaching. These early reading skills are so important for preparing children for a life of learning. Special thank you to the teachers for organising this and to the children for carrying on as usual. Well done, Kingsway!

Year 2 In science, as part of our learning about a healthy, balanced diet, we made and tasted a raspberry and apple smoothie. The children described it as both sweet and sour! In D&T, we continued our learning about mechanisms and started to make our ferris wheels. We attached our wheel to the base using an axle so it can spin.







Year 1 In Design and Technology this week we were making smoothies. We prepared our fruits by cutting, juicing and crushing. Then we tasted them and decided which ingredients we would like to add to our smoothies. We used a blender to make the smoothies, it was absolutely delicious! In Geography, we located some places in our local area and identified different features on the map using the key.



Reception In our literacy lessons, we have been reading "The Squirrels Who Squabbled". During our discussions, we explored the theme of friendship, focusing on the qualities that make a good friend. We emphasised how important it is to help each other, recognising this as a valuable trait in building and maintaining friendships. In Maths, our exploration centered around the concept of classifying objects. We discovered that objects can often possess more than one attribute, which allows them to fit into multiple groups.
