Reception We started phonics this week and have been looking around our environment for objects that start with our new sounds, we found a very BIG spider when looking for objects starting with 's'. We have also been developing our gross motor skills on the obstacle course this week, working as a team playing football and helping our friends to hit the ball with the hockey sticks. We've also been busy in the garden, harvesting our runner beans so we can take out the seeds for a new crop.



Year 1 In English, we explored a book called 'Journey' by Aaron Becker. We discussed the features of a fiction book, these included the title, the author and the blurb. Using a mind map we described what we liked and disliked about the book, we then sequenced a story to summarise the book. In Maths, we talked about how numbers can be represented in different ways using dice, tens frames and counters. We then matched these to the correct digits.

Year 2 In Maths, we used our number bonds to 10 to help us to solve addition sums. We regrouped numbers to make our sum easier. For example, we could see that $8+5$ is the same as $10+3$ and they both equal 13. In geography, we have continued learning about the continents. We wrote facts all about Africa. We learnt it is the second biggest continent and the reason it is so hot is because the equator runs through the middle of it.
