Where learning is fun!

This week we had a visit from PCSO Gunn, who talked to the children about road safety. The children enjoyed his assembly, but did want to know about catching baddies! Reception In literacy, we have been exploring the delightful story of "Pumpkin Soup". We discussed the different characters in the story and the special jobs they each had, which sparked engaging conversations about teamwork and responsibility. Building on our story discussions, we then created a list of all the ingredients needed to make pumpkin soup. We wrote detailed instructions on how to prepare the soup and then followed these instructions and tried making our own soup! In Maths, we have been focusing on comparing objects. We have been comparing them by their thickness and weight, which has been a fun way to explore measurement.



This week, Year 2 learnt how to be great 'Play Buddies'. We spoke about qualities that make a good play buddy and then practised setting up games that we could lead on the playground. You might see us with some special

'Sports Star' stickers to show we have been playing games with others. In art, we created some wax resist artwork. We used the skills we have been learning to help us create detailed observational drawings with wax crayons. Then, we painted over the top and saw how the wax resisted the paint.









Year 1 This week in English we have been continuing with our poems, we have created our own class poems remembering our adjectives to describe our coloured objects and thinking about our actions when performing to the class. In Maths, we were learning a new strategy, think 5, by regrouping our 10s frame to show 5 and a bit more. In Computing, we were continuing our typing skills trying to keep our fingers on the home row keys to type.
