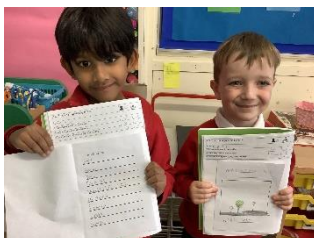
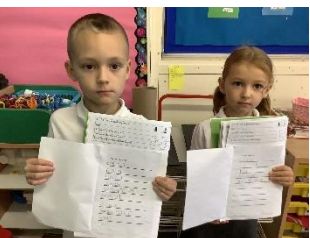
Head Teacher's Award

Year 2 We have written our own narrative based on the book 'Frog and the Stranger'. We used capital letters for names, conjunctions to join sentences together and we wrote in the past tense. We performed our story to our audience, our class mates. In Science, we predicted what the chicks would look like when they hatched. We then went to visit the chicks when they hatched to see if our predictions were correct.

Year 1 In English, we have made our own gardening booklet writing a list with what we would need, remembering that a list goes down the page. In History we have been learning about Guy Fawkes and the problems that he and the plotters faced, using drama to think about what they might have said. In PE, we have been working on our running skills e.g our heads are up, our arms are swinging and we are on the balls of our feet.



Reception We have been learning new sounds in phonics, listening carefully to identify these sounds in the stories we read together. We have also been brainstorming different words that start with each new sound.
