A message from Mrs Knights



Year 1 have been creating mirror dance moves to demonstrate how they plant a seed and Year 2 have been investigating which foods are grown, farmed or caught. Reception We have been exploring weight using scales. We discovered that when something is heavy, it makes the bucket go down and when something it lighter the bucket will go up. We explored the effect of different size objects and materials to see what would happen, we found out that just because something is big does not mean it will be the heaviest. We have also been celebrating black history month by reading lots of stories from different authors, it has been lovely reading stories about lots of different families.

















Year 2 We have been writing instructions on how to be a good friend. We came up with adjectives to describe a good friend such as helpful, kind, happy and friendly. We then turned these into commands for how to be a good friend. We created freeze frames for these commands and acted out being a good friend. We thought of ideas such as 'help your friend if they are hurt' or 'play with your friend so they are not left out'. 
