Year 2 As part of our anti-bullying week, we have been on a mission to spread kindness. We had a discussion about kindness and decided to act by creating kindness cards. In these, we wrote messages to say why we are thankful for each person and then handed them out! We have also been busy writing a narrative about our journey around the school. The children used so many powerful verbs like 'soared' and 'zipped' throughout their work!



Reception We have been reading 'Owl Babies' by Martin Waddell. We have been finding lots of ways to retell the story, either by creating books, using puppets or a story board. We have also looked at speech bubbles and how these tell us what our characters are saying, we then had a go at adding speech bubbles to our story. In Maths, we have been grouping objects by their attributes and discussing the similarities and difference between our objects, for example - when sorting shapes, we looked at the attributes of how many sides a shape has and found out if we grouped all the shapes with 4 sides then, squares, rectangles and diamonds could all be grouped together as they all have 4 sides.

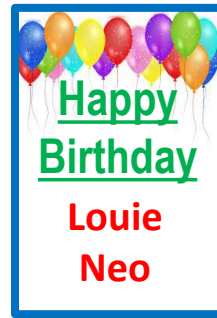
