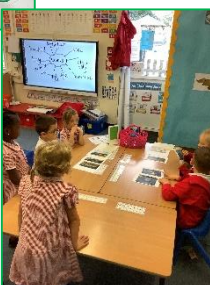
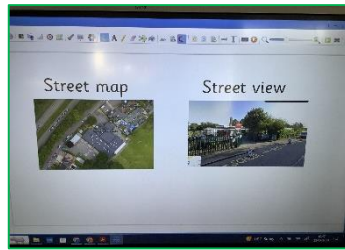


Reception. We have been on a treasure hunt looking for objects that start with our new sounds, we then placed them in our treasure chest. In Maths, we've been working on our counting skills. We found out that if we move objects as we count we can count more accurately how many we have in a group. We went on a senses walk this week to explore what we can see, hear, feel, smell and taste in our environment.

Year 2 We had an exciting week watching our chicks hatch! In science, we have been learning about the life cycle of a chicken. We got to hold the chicks, they are so cute and fluffy! In English, we have been reading the story 'Frog and the Stranger'. We have been learning about conjunctions, so, every time we saw a conjunction in the text, we stamped our feet!



Year 1 We have been exploring emotions. We shared our experiences when we felt excited, calm, nervous, scared.
